

HOSPITALITY

PURCHASER shall provide refreshments and catering for ARTIST as follows:

IMPORTANT: Beverages ONLY are to be served before performance; Food served AFTER performance; Food to be left for ARTIST for up to 3 hours following performance!

BACKSTAGE

- a. Napkins or paper towels & disposables (i.e., cutlery, paper plates)
- b. 12 bottles of assorted Sodas (REGULAR AND DIET SOFT DRINKS)
- c. Cold Rolling Rock, Corona or Amstel Light Beer; (18 bottles minimum)
- d. Cold bottled Water (12 bottles minimum)
- e. Fruit Juice (6 bottles minimum). ALL-NATURAL --- NO HIGH FRUCTOSE CORN SWEETENER PLEASE! Lemonade, cranberry juice, apple juice, orange juice, carrot juice acceptable
- f. Iced coffee (4 bottles minimum). I.e., Starbucks
- g. Ice & cups
- h. Corn tortilla chips & salsa
- i. Crudite (vegetable) platter w/ pita chips & dip (i.e., hummus, bleu cheese, ranch dressing, etc.)

ONSTAGE

- a. 4 5 clean towels (one per musician);
- b. 8 10 cold bottled waters.

MEALS

If food is served at venue, meals for up to 5 (five) band members and 2 (two) crew will also be provided. Meals include 1 lunch, 1 dinner and 1 breakfast for each 24-hour cycle at venue location. If food is NOT served at venue: PURCHASER must provide hot delivered meals.

BUFFET MEALS/WAIT SERVICE.

If meals are served in public buffet environment (i.e., casino buffet), ARTIST may request BUYER provide service staff to "run" and plate meals for ARTIST to avoid pre-show publicity, long lines, etc.
